2. Players/Members must inform Coaches or the General Manager at least one hour before practice for an excused absence.
3. Three absences from practice without player notification are cause for a verbal caution, three subsequent absences will attract a written caution followed by expulsion from the academy after two subsequent absences.
4. Any disruption of the learning environment (talking and fidgeting with phones while coaches are talking, horseplay), reported misconduct at home or in the community, fighting, swearing, disrespect of peers or Coaches and instructors, breaking ground rules including hanging around Block B on non-training days, insubordination, or lack of effort, is cause for expulsion from practice.
5. An unexcused absence could result in suspension (at the Coach's discretion).
6. Players/Members will not enrol in any other sporting academy as long as they remain members of AGSA.
7. In the event of a player joining any academy or club, AGSA will take full responsibility of the transfer and facilitate the same as the mother academy of the said player/member
8. During meetings, only coaches and instructors will give directions to Players/Members. Parents should not "coach" their wards from the sidelines as this may conflict with the direction provided by the Coaches and could be confusing for the Players/Members.
9. Consenting parents understand and agree to completely indemnify AGSA for any expenses or liabilities as a result of any injury or any other loss to the members including the cost of emergency services.
10. Consenting parents understand and agree that AGSA or its representatives, volunteers, and sponsors will not be held responsible for any theft, any untoward actions, or any damages or destruction of property caused by their wards during meetings.
